Committee Descriptions

****Please take note of which days each committee works****

Admissions: Responsible for ticket sales at admission gates, off-course parking lots, and clubhouse. (Thursday – Sunday)

Beverage: Volunteers will help with the distribution of product for players and caddies on the golf course and make sure it is stocked each morning and throughout the day. (Monday – Sunday)

Caddie Hospitality: This committee is responsible for helping with the needs of the caddie tent throughout the week. (Monday – Sunday)

Clubhouse/Security: This committee is responsible for greeting and verifying credentials for everyone that enters the clubhouse and hospitality areas. (Monday-Sunday)

Construction: This committee is responsible for erecting everything that will be needed for the tournament including signage, scoreboards, Press Room, fences, stake and rope, and more. Help will be mainly needed before and after the tournament and will require intense labor. (Saturday and Sunday before and late Sunday afternoon)

Golf Channel: This committee will work with the Golf channel on the all aspects of the tournament broadcast. There will be a mandatory meeting on Wednesday of tournament week. (Wednesday – Sunday)

Marshals: The Marshal's responsibilities consist of providing control over the gallery, cross walks, ball spotting, rope and gate maintenance for every hole and moving throughout the course during tournament week. This is a standing and/or walking position. (Thursday – Sunday)

Parking: This committee monitors the public, player, caddie, and VIP parking lots during the tournament. (Monday-Sunday)

Scoring Central/Communications: These trained volunteers monitor and update the PGA TOUR scoring system throughout each tournament day as well as the leaderboards throughout the course. These individuals must be knowledgeable of golf and golf scoring. (Thursday – Sunday)

Standard Bearer: Carry standard with assigned group displaying player's name and scores
Change scores as needed after each hole by checking with the Walking Scorer. You will be asked to carry a sign for an entire round of golf (approximately 5 hours). (Thursday – Sunday)

Starter/Announcer: Starters are located on the 1st and 10th tees and are responsible for introducing the professional golfers as they prepare to tee off. (Thursday – Sunday)

Transportation: Shuttling players, caddies, and volunteers as needed on the golf course. Provide transportation services for players and officials as needed and help manage parking assignments for spectators, volunteers, media, players, and officials.

Volunteer Village: Help with check-in of volunteers each day as well as the distribution of meals. (Monday – Sunday)

Walking Scorers: Volunteers must be available to work an entire round and walk an entire 18 holes. A thorough knowledge of golf is necessary for this position and training will be provided. (Thursday – Sunday)
