## Committee Preferences

Please review the following information and send in your application as soon as you can. Positions are filled on a first come, first serve basis. Please list your top three (3) committee selections in order of preference (1 through 3; 1 being your top choice). We will do our best to assign you to one of your top 3 choices; however, some committees fill quickly so you may be assigned to a committee that needs additional volunteers. Committee descriptions are available below. For additional committee information, please call 229-242-8455. **You will be notified of your committee assignment in March of 2011. We will also send your Availability Form at this time.**

\_\_\_ **Access Control\*:** Work in conjunction with Corporate Hospitality Committee and the contracted security company to ensure tournament guests have the proper credentials to enter various restricted areas.

\_\_\_ **Admissions:** Sell and issue daily tickets, manage Will Call function and check tickets/credentials at admissions gates.

\_\_\_ **Caddie Bibs:** Responsible for distributing and collecting the caddie bibs prior to and after each tournament round. Volunteers will also be responsible for organizing the bibs in the proper order for the next round.

\_\_\_ **Caddie Hospitality:** Handle caddie registration and provide information as needed. Volunteers on this committee will not serve as caddies during the tournament.

\_\_\_ **Construction\*:** This committee is responsible for erecting everything that will be needed for the tournament including signage, scoreboards, stake and rope, and more. Help will be mainly needed before and after the tournament and will require intense labor.

\_\_\_ **Marshals\*:** Serve as a marshal to ensure players are not disturbed during play and enforce crowd control and golf etiquette among spectators.

\_\_\_ **Parking/Traffic\*:** Work with local Law Enforcement to help implement the Tournament's parking and busing plan.

\_\_\_ **Product Delivery\*:** Stock and deliver on-course refreshments to tee boxes and distribute pairing sheets. May require heavy lifting.

\_\_\_ **Player Registration:** Duties include welcoming players and providing them with necessary credentials plus general information about the tournament, Shoal Creek and the surrounding area.

\_\_\_ **Scoring Central/Communications:** These trained volunteers monitor and update the PGA TOUR scoring system throughout each tournament day as well as the leaderboards throughout the course. These individuals must be knowledgeable of golf and golf scoring. (Thursday – Sunday)

\_\_\_ **Scoring Tent/Scorecard Runner\*:** Responsible for validating and transferring the professionals' scorecards to PGA officials. (Thursday – Sunday, A.M. and P.M. shifts available)

\_\_\_ **Standard Bearers\*:** Responsible for carrying a two-sided scoring standard, which is a portable status board and for posting players' scores to keep spectators posted on how each player stands with respect to par, both in the round being played and cumulatively.

\_\_\_ **Starters/Announcers\*:** Responsible for announcing Pro-Am Players and Tournament Players (during Tournament rounds) as they approach the tee box to begin a round.

\_\_\_ **Transportation\*:** Shuttling players, caddies, and volunteers as needed on the golf course. Provide transportation services for players and officials as needed and help manage parking assignments for spectators, volunteers, media, players, and officials.

\_\_\_ **TV Spotters\*:** Assist the Golf Channel in updating scoring information for TV Coverage.

\_\_\_ **Volunteer Headquarters:** Responsible for the operation of the volunteer hospitality village during Tournament Week.

\_\_\_ **Walking Scorers\*:** Record accurate hole-by-hole information for each player in group and transmit this information to Scoring Central via handheld computers. Must have thorough knowledge of golf, be comfortable working with handheld computer and be able to walk 18 holes regardless of weather conditions.

# Volunteer Release Form



**Volunteer Credential Terms:** You grant permission to PGA TOUR to utilize your image or likeness incidental to any live or recorded television or other transmission or reproduction in whole or in part of the tournament. You agree not to transmit or facilitate transmission of any account, description, picture, or reproduction of the tournament, including, without limitation, scoring-related data, without the specific advance written permission of the PGA TOUR. Soliciting autographs from tournament players with intent to sell is prohibited. You agree that you shall not seek autographs of players in order to sell such autographs, and you shall not pay another person to obtain an autograph for you. For security purposes, no bags larger than six inches will be permitted onto the golf course, including purses, chair bags, and camera cases. You hereby consent to the reasonable inspection of your person and property before entering the tournament, which inspection may include, without limitation, metal detection. No food, coolers, ladders, signs, banners, mobile phones, PDA's, radios, televisions, firearms, explosive devices, etc. will be permitted on the grounds. All pagers must be on vibrate. NO cameras or camcorders are allowed during tournament rounds. No alcoholic beverages may be brought onto or taken from the grounds of the tournament. You agree to abide by all rules and regulations established by the PGA TOUR and the tournament, and a violation of such rules and regulations, including failure to appear for a scheduled volunteer shift, can be a cause for termination of the license granted herein, forfeiture of the volunteer credential and your removal from the tournament. The volunteer credential cannot be used in a promotion or offered as a prize without permission from PGA TOUR. Resale of the volunteer credential is not permitted. It is unlawful to reproduce the volunteer credential. PGA TOUR reserves the right to revoke this credential and cancel all privileges connected therein.

**RELEASE OF LIABILITY:** In connection with my activities or the activities of my minor child as a volunteer at the 2011 South Georgia Classic presented by First State Bank and Trust Company, I agree and understand that the presence of me or my child at the tournament and any volunteer work or services performed by me or my child for the tournament, its sponsors, the facility, Bruno Event Team, LLC, PGA TOUR, their affiliates and subsidiaries and their respective officers, directors, agents, members, employees and officials as well as any other volunteer (collectively, "Indemnified Parties") may expose me or my child to unknown and unanticipated risks of harm or injury. In consideration of and as a prerequisite to the participation of me or my child as a volunteer, I, for myself and my child, acknowledge that such risks exist, assume all such risks, and release and discharge the Indemnified Parties from any and all claims for liability for personal injury (including death) or property damage that I or my child may suffer while performing such volunteer work or service, whether or not on the premises of the Facility, including, without limitation, any claim arising out of any condition of the premises owned by the facility or used by Bruno Event Team, LLC or PGA TOUR for, or conduct or any person during preparation, supervision or conduct of, the tournament or any practice round or activity related to it. I further understand that the Indemnified Parties will not maintain insurance to cover me or my child for personal injury, property damage or medical expenses, and I accept full responsibility for the costs of treatment for any injury or damages suffered by me or my child while volunteering with the tournament. I have read this release before signing it and agree to be bound by its terms in consideration for volunteering.
