### Committee Descriptions

**\*\*Please take note of which days each committee works\*\***

**A Team:** A great way to try many different areas. Volunteers will be assigned duties daily.

**Beverage:** Volunteers help with the distribution of beverages for players and caddies on the golf course and make sure coolers are stocked each morning and throughout the day. ***Must be able to lift up to 35 lbs.*** (Monday – Sunday, A.M. and P.M. shifts available)

**Clubhouse/Parking:** This committee is responsible for greeting and verifying credentials for everyone that enters the clubhouse and parking lots. (Monday-Sunday, A.M. and P.M. shifts available)

**Golf Channel:** This committee will work with the Golf Channel on all aspects of the tournament broadcast. Duties include but not limited to ball spotting and holding a microphone while following particular groups of professionals around the course. (Thursday – Sunday, *typically 10:30 am – 5 pm*)

**Marshals:** The Marshal's responsibilities consist of providing control over the gallery, cross walks, ball spotting, rope and gate maintenance for every hole and moving throughout the course during tournament week. This is a standing and/or walking position. (Thursday – Sunday, early A.M., midday, and evening shifts available)

**Scoring Tent/Scorecard Runner:** Responsible for validating and transferring the professionals' scorecards to PGA officials. (Thursday – Sunday, A.M. and P.M. shifts available)

**Skybox Security:** Responsible for greeting and verifying credentials for patrons that enter the hospitality skyboxes around the greens. Also responsible for noise control once the professionals arrive at the greens. (Thursday – Sunday, A.M. and P.M. shifts available)

**Standard Bearer:** Carry standard with assigned group displaying player's name and scores. Change scores as needed after each hole by checking with the Walking Scorer. You will be asked to carry a sign for an entire round of golf (approximately 5 hours). (Saturday – Sunday)

**Transportation:** Shuttling players, caddies, and volunteers as needed on the golf course. Provide transportation services for players and officials as needed and help manage parking assignments for spectators, volunteers, media, players, and officials. (Monday – Sunday, A.M. and P.M. shifts available)

**Volunteer Village:** Help with check-in of volunteers each day as well as the distribution of meals. (Monday – Sunday, A.M. and P.M. shifts available)

**Walking Scorers:** Volunteers must be available to work an entire round and walk an entire 18 holes. A slight knowledge of golf is necessary for this position and training will be provided. (Thursday – Sunday)
